- Builds a relationship of trust and respect with clients
- Listens to clients' concerns, provides empathy, and guides them to see things more clearly or differently, using therapeutic frameworks
- Follows Centre policies, protocols and procedures
- Willing and able to be supervised in your clinical work. Being open to feedback.
